


Topirum Primary School has a CCTV system installed and operational, as part of the VSBA build of the school completing in 2024.

Approval to install CCTV in Victorian government schools must be sought from the Security Unit. 5. Resources are provided to support schools to install, manage and use CCTV effectively (following approval), including: installation and maintenance checklists; recommended products, installers, and technical specifications; and advice on signage, privacy, and communication.
